Vandalism	•	Students will be respectful of all school property and the property of others. In doing so, they will understand that it is not acceptable to vandalize.  Parents will reinforce the understanding that vandalism is not acceptable.  School staff will model appropriate behaviour	•	A student who vandalizes will be required to compensate for full repair of the vandalism. Depending on the circumstances, the student may be assigned community service.  A student who vandalizes at school or during the school day may be suspended externally for up to three school days.

Drug & Alcohol Use and the Sale of Drugs and/or Alcohol	•	Students will refrain from using and/or trafficking drugs and/or alcohol at school. Students will not present themselves at school or at school events under the influence of alcohol or any illegal drug.  Parents will ensure that their children understand the law.	•	A student who is caught under the influence, in possession, or trafficking alcohol or illegal drugs will be suspended for ten school days. The police educator will be involved and will intervene with the student. Parents will be notified. As well, a re-entry meeting with parents will be held. The principal will follow up with the student upon his/her return to school.
	•	School staff will enforce the drug and alcohol policy; if and when necessary, school staff will impose the measures as indicated in the school policy.	•	A student who is caught trafficking alcohol or drugs or with a quantity of alcohol or drugs deemed to be for the purpose of sale (as determined by the police) will be suspended for ten school days and will be referred to a discipline committee hearing.

Physical Aggression/ Physical Assault	•	Students will refrain from any type of physical confrontation.  Parents will enforce the understanding that physical confrontation will not solve conflict or disagreement.  School staff will model appropriate behaviour and will follow up with the necessary measures when the policy is violated.	•	Two students who enter into a minor physical altercation (ie. pushing/shoving each other) may be suspended for one school day.  Two students who enter into a physical confrontation whereby punches or kicks are administered or someone physically assaults another person will be suspended out of school for1-3 school days.
Bullying	•	Students will behave appropriately, respecting individual differences and diversity – to take a stand against bullying. They will report and inform (parents/guardians, school staff, friends) if they are being bullied or if they see someone else being bullied. Students will help someone who is being bullied by taking a stand – reporting and supporting.  Parents will watch for signs that their child may be the victim of bullying and watch for signs that their child is exhibiting bullying behavior. They will speak to a teacher or administrator if their child is being bullied or they suspect that their child is bullying others. They will encourage open conversations with adults and encourage their children to tell a responsible adult if they are being bullied or suspect others are bullying.	•	Official warning to stop offending (verbal and written) to the students and parents.  A student may be automatically suspended from school if the act of bullying is considered severe regardless if there have been previous issues.  After a serious bullying incident, parents of both the victim and the student(s) committing the bullying-type behaviour are notified. The parents are informed of the allegations and are also informed about the student's responses to these allegations (verbal and written). If they do not stop engaging in bullying behaviours after any warning from school staff, students will be suspended from school.  Students who bully others may face one or more of the following consequences:  Involvement in mediation;  Parents will be contacted by the school;  Recommendation for an out-of-school assessment;

The staff will treat all reports or observed incidences of bullying seriously by reporting them immediately the appropriate administrator. The staff will provide and foster an environment where students feel they can speak to staff about their concerns.
